Every preregistered exhibitor is granted admission only to the grounds for themselves w/ minors receiving a plus 1 for guardian. All others regardless if arriving together will be charged admission (\$15 and includes ride bracelet).**

### SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

#### GROUND & ARENA

1. Lamoille County Field Days (LCFD) prohibits the use of alcohol on the fairgrounds as well as dogs on the grounds with the exception of Service Dogs.
2. By entering in an LCFD equine event every participant agrees to abide by Lamoille County Field Days rules.
3. No Stabling is available on the grounds. Exhibitors may arrive on the fairgrounds starting at 9:00 a.m. and all horses must be removed within 2 hours of the conclusion of the show. Please pickup after yourself and your horse(s) before leaving.
4. Riders must be in control of their horse at all times when on the fairgrounds. No cantering outside of the Main arena, or Warm-up arena. Warm-up arena is located to the left of the gate of the main arena and will be marked as such. No horses are allowed around the food area or past the secretary booth.
5. **Approved ASTM helmets are required for all riders under the age of 18 and strongly encouraged for all riders.**
6. Riders ride at their own risk and are responsible for any and all damage caused by them or their horse.
7. You will be **DISQUALIFIED** for breaking the pattern and a 5 second penalty will be added for obstacles knocked over.
8. Must enter the ring within 60seconds of your name being called or you will be disqualified.
9. Riders should have their horse under control and walking by the time they are exiting the chute.
10. Any un-sportsman like behavior or excessive force used on any horse will automatically be disqualified without refund.

#### DIVISIONS:

**Walk/Trot** – this division is open to anyone. Cantering is prohibited and if excessive/repeated cantering is witnessed on LCFD grounds the exhibitor will be moved up to the next appropriate division.

**Youth Intermediate** – Walk, Trot & CONTROLLED Canter. Must be 17yrs or younger.

**Youth Open** – Walk, Trot, Canter, Gallop. Must be 17yrs or younger.

**Adult Intermediate** – Walk, Trot, CONTROLLED Canter. Must be 18yrs or older.

**Adult Open** – Walk, Trot, Canter, Gallop. Must be 18yrs or older.

**Leadline** – Exhibitors must be accompanied by a handler and can walk, trot & canter. Handler must always remain between the shoulder and head of horse. Open to youth riders 14yrs old and younger.

*\*\*LCFD's arena has well maintained grass footing. All exhibitors, even those in the open divisions, are expected to maintain a level of safety with their speed. We want everyone to have fun, be competitive but our utmost priority is the safety of our exhibitors & the horses.*

**PARKING** – LCFD has limited trailer parking. Trailers will be the only vehicles allowed for ON-GROUNDS parking via the back gate. All other vehicles will need to park in the regular LCFD parking areas that are outside of the grounds. Parking is free for all and exhibitors are welcome to enter through the back gate to drop/unload, but their vehicles must be moved promptly to the front lots once unloaded. **ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING OF ANY KIND ON THE SIDES OF THE PULLING ARENA OR SHOW ARENA.**

#### PAYBACKS & DAY END CHAMPIONSHIPS:

Each division will have a day end champion and reserve champion. Exhibitors must participate in all 6 games to qualify for day end awards. Paybacks will be awarded to the division winners of each game. The division must have 2 or more exhibitors for paybacks to be awarded. The winner will receive \$1 for every exhibitor in their division for each game. Champion winners receive \$3 per exhibitor in their division. Reserve Champion Winners receive \$2 per exhibitor in their division.
